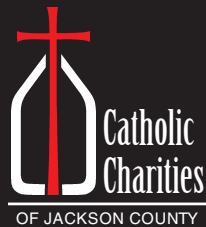

Respite Services 782-3878

- Serves family caregivers in their home. Volunteers offer companionship and supervision to the homebound adult (caregiver or homebound adult must be age 50 or older to qualify for this service).

Retired & Senior Volunteer Program (RSVP) 782-4616

- Provides volunteer opportunities for seniors (age 55 years and older) to non-profit agencies within the community.
