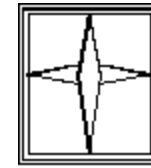

HOMEBOUND MEALS/  
FOOD SUPPLIES

-Available through the Livingston County Senior Nutrition Program. ( 517 ) 545-7198

TRANSPORTATION

-Available through a network of volunteers

HOME CARE

-Skilled nursing, occupational and physical therapy, medical social work.

RESPITE

-Trained volunteers bring temporary relief to family caregiver.

PRESCRIPTIONS

-Emergency prescription assistance is available for income eligible seniors, through Livingston County Catholic Charities.

MEDICARE/MEDICAID

-Help explain eligibility & services covered.

IN-HOME SERVICES

-Personal care and light housekeeping.

ADULT DAY CARE SERVICES

-Respite care for caregivers

COUNSELING
