The Campaign Cabinet is in place and meeting this week. The brochure is being reviewed and almost ready for print! Bulletin inserts are in place and Fr. John is ready for Announcement Weekend is this coming weekend.

The ALPHA program has launched and we will be formally announcing the Witness To Hope campaign **at Christ the King Parish** in Ann Arbor on the weekend of September 23/24. **Fr. Ed Fride** will be reaching out to parish families to invite their participation in the combined campaign, which will allow Christ the King to complete projects to enhance parish life and to serve many of the extraordinary programs currently underway.

Fr. Tim McDonald has begun to schedule personal campaign visits that will begin next week, while simultaneously completing the case brochure. He is putting together a team of leaders and our timeline has been set. Along with his staff, Fr. Tim has completed a thorough review of the database as well.

In addition to initiating the parish engagement phase at **Old St. Patrick Parish** in Ann Arbor we also met with the Parish Council on September 8th. Although it was a Friday night, and not a typical meeting day, the group was most enthusiastic, with great questions and a sincere interest in helping both the parish and Diocese successfully execute the WTH campaign. Like every parish, there are challenges, but there is also a great spirit of cooperation from **Fr. Tom Wasilewski** and his leadership team.

After making his remarkable *decision of faith / best sacrifice gift* to the campaign, **Fr. Tom Firestone** at the **Catholic Community of Flint** is reaching out to parish leaders for conversations about *Witness to Hope* and early decisions of faith. Parish share funds will further build up parish life through Evangelization, Education and Charitable Outreach especially at the St. Luke N.E.W Life Center where lives are saved and lives are changed daily. **Fr. Philip Schmitter** at **Christ the King** in **Flint** is inviting his co chairs and parish leaders in for conversations about *Witness to Hope.* He will invite all to consider early gift decisions to drive campaign momentum. **Fr. Phil** continues to clearly communicate the spirituality of sacrificial giving. Parish share funds will drive outreach and evangelization to empower the poor and share the Catholic faith in Flint.

Fr. Robert Copeland and Fr. Todd Koenigsknecht at **St. John the Evangelist, Fenton** will meet with parish leaders immediately following the '17 Apple Fest for conversations about *Witness to Hope* and their gift to the parish and wider church. Parish share funds will reduce Debt, upgrade Facilities and make needed improvements to the historic stone Chapel.

Fr. James Mangan at **St. Matthew, Flint** will meet with several motivated and capable cabinet co chair candidates soon. Parish share funds will enhance Evangelization, Education and Charitable Outreach at **St. Matthew** as a witness to the Catholic faith in downtown Flint.

Fr. James Conlon, St. Francis of Assisi, Ann Arbor kicked off the parish's \$8 million combined campaign last weekend with a special homily at all six Masses. The parish share of \$6.3 million will fund the new 15,000 sq. ft. Ministry Center, to be built adjacent to the Church. The Building Committee provided Father four beautiful architectural drawings of the Center. These were on display in the narthex and also at the annual parish picnic held on Sunday afternoon and have been posted to the website. The drawings created a lot of excitement and many positive comments - parishioners were thrilled to see what their pledges will be supporting. The first campaign reception will be held on Tuesday morning September 19th for the "55 and Faster" senior ministry group.

St. Mary, Morrice just concluded their annual parish festival. **James Lothamer PSS** is continuing to appeal to the parish leadership to consider a finical contribution in support to *Witness to Hope*. Fr. Jim will be announcing The Campaign publically at Mass in the next two weeks.

St. Mary, Durand and **St. Joseph, Gaines** will be hosting Bishop Boyea to present on *Witness to Hope* on Monday, September 18th at 6:00 PM. **Fr. Jonathan Perrotta** has publically invited parishioners to attend this meeting at St. Mary for families to listen and learn about The Campaign. Families continue to prayerfully consider their support as enthusiasm builds in the parish.

Fr. Dwight Ezop at **Catholic Community of St. Mary and St. Ann, Charlotte / Bellevue** continues to call upon the parish leadership to assist in the campaign process. Families are making generous contributions to support the campaign as the message continues to be shared.

The cabinet will host it's first small group gathering this coming Saturday. **Fr. Brendan** is almost done with all remaining leadership calls.
