On the First Sunday of Advent, 2011, the dioceses of the United States will begin to use the third edition of the Roman Missal. While the Order of Mass will not change, we will experience new English translations of some of our current texts.

This presents a golden opportunity to catechize on the rich theology of our Eucharistic celebrations and to examine the beauty of our liturgical texts. As a member of your parish's implementation team, how will you help your parishioners participate more fully, to pray more deeply, and to understand the changes to long-familiar responses and prayers?

Please join us at one of six regional workshops! We will explore the history of the Missal, review the process of translation and the documents that guided it, examine new texts, sing new dialogues and prayers, and review processes and resources which will assist you in this important catechetical endeavor.
