This use to be quite a regular occurrence for me when our three children lived at home. When they were infants Jon was hired as our Music Director leaving me at home to get all three ready and out the door on time. I went from feeding and dressing one at a time, carefully planning how much time I had to walking through the house in their teen years screaming, "THE CHURCH BUS LEAVES IN 30, 15, 5 MINUTES AND I HOPE WE DON'T GET STOPPED BY A TRAIN."

Now, it's just me at home and I always think I have far more time than I really do. Especially, when I go to Mass on Saturday night. Last Saturday night I didn't plan my time well and I was the Lector for 4:30 Mass. I was suppose to arrive 15 minutes early. I only live 6 minutes from our church but the car in front of me obviously didn't have the same destination. I am guilty of tailgating and even that did not move them along any faster. As soon as we reached the traffic light, I pulled in the passing lane and blew past them. It was obvious that I was irritated but I didn't care. I had places to be.

I was on my way down main street with one more traffic light to clear. Just as I got to the light it turned red. I glanced in my rear view mirror and the car I blew past stopped behind me. The light turned green, I made my turn and the car behind me followed. My mind started to race and I said out loud, "oh please Lord, do not let them go to Mass." I knew in my heart they would see me walk across the parking lot.

Guess what? Sure enough they turned on to St. Mary Blvd and followed me into the parking lot. I sat in my car and thought, here I am Lord, short on patience and feeling like I am the most important person in the world. I wished for the first time ever that I had not been asked to be the Lector at Mass. Standing up and proclaim the word while all the time wondering if the couple thought, "is she for real?" became a very humbling moment. Proclaiming and living it go hand in hand. I really failed that night.
