- 1. Please be sure to <u>list your legal name</u> (e.g. Maiden Name) at time the Sacrament was completed
- 2. Please DO NOT use nicknames or derivatives unless that is your legal name (i.e. Charlie vs Charles)
- 3. The Date of Birth is **required**. Date of Sacrament is helpful
- 4. <u>Tribunal</u>: If you are requesting a spouse's certificate for the annulment process, please state that on the form and include the name and address of your Advocate. The certificate can only be sent <u>directly</u> to the Advocate.
- 5. <u>Marriage Prep</u>: Please include the name of the Catholic Church where you are doing your marriage prep, the church address, city, state, zip. Include the name of the person you are working with for your marriage prep. The certificate will be sent directly to the parish where you are doing your marriage prep. If you are requesting the certificate more than 6 months out from the wedding date, please check with your coordinator. Most require the certificate to be dated within 6 months of the wedding date.
- 6. <u>Parents</u>: You can request a sacramental records certificate for your child <u>if</u> they are a minor (under 18 yrs of age) or you have legal guardianship for an adult son/daughter. Otherwise, once they turn 18 yrs of age, they will need to complete the form to request their own records.
